Super Bowl LX Party Costs Are Through The Roof Thanks to Trump

On Sunday evening, Americans across the country will tune in to watch the Seahawks play the Patriots, bookended by performances by Bad Bunny and Green Day, in Super Bowl LX. With food prices across the spectrum [rising faster than inflation](#), there's no question Donald Trump's terrible economic agenda is [driving up party costs](#). This year, party hosts are paying a premium thanks to Trump's tariffs keeping inflation high. Centerpiece appetizers like layered nachos and buffalo wings are all more expensive this year as beef prices soar and chicken wing prices remain high, with no help from the White House in sight. Soda and beer are pricier too, driven up by Trump's tariffs on aluminum.

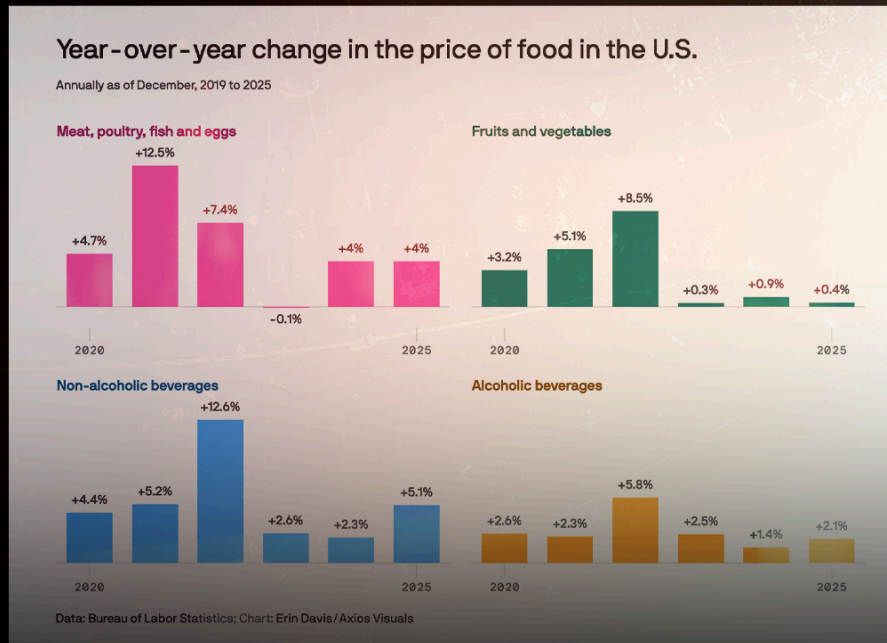
Super Bowl Price Hikes

- **The cost of attending a football game in-person is becoming increasingly unaffordable, [pricing out](#) many fans from attending.**
 - The average NFL ticket [cost](#) **more than \$300** this season.
 - This season, the [cheapest ticket](#) to an average NFL game was **around \$169**.
 - **Football tickets have soared in the U.S.**, while similarly popular soccer games in Europe and the UK [remain low-priced](#) in comparison. Even college football games in the U.S. are [becoming more expensive as well](#), pricing out even hometown fans.

- **The cost of watching football at home is rising too.** Despite Trump’s [claims](#) to the contrary, **grocery prices are rising faster than inflation** (with [no sign of stopping](#)), hitting lower-income households the hardest. As of last month, grocery store prices are **nearly 26% higher** than they were five years ago. The National Retail Federation predicts that total Super Bowl spending could [climb](#) around 9% this year compared to last, driven largely by the cost of food and drinks.

- With tariffs hiking prices, Trump's terrible economic agenda is **driving up party costs** for hosts and guests [alike](#). Super Bowl LX watchers are **facing high 'snackflation'** this year, as prices for chips, drinks, and appetizers rise:

- **Nachos**
 - Salsa has [increased](#) 38% since 2021
 - Tortilla prices are [up](#) nearly 34% since 2021
 - Sour cream is [up](#) 29% since 2021
 - Beef prices are [up](#) 15.5% *this year alone*
 - Cheddar cheese is [up](#) 13% since 2021
- **Buffalo wings**
 - Chicken is [up](#) nearly 27% since 2021
 - Hot sauce prices are [up](#) around 29% since 2021
 - Butter is [up](#) nearly 32% since 2021
- **Beverages**
 - Soda and other carbonated drinks are [up](#) 27% compared to 2021
 - Beer is [up](#) 16% since 2021
 - Aluminum, the primary metal used in beer and soda cans, has [risen](#) above \$1 a pound in the US for the first time in history thanks to Trump's tariffs, prompting a [spike](#) in canning costs that [many breweries](#) have been [forced](#) to pass to consumers.
- **Pigs in a Blanket**
 - Crescent dough is [up](#) 24% since 2021
 - Mini hotdogs are [up](#) 26% since 2021
- **Chips**
 - Potato chips are [up](#) 37% since 2021
